REGULATORY DEPARTMENT

Arizona Research Center's regulatory specialists process the study start-up paperwork and work diligently to maintain all regulatory documents throughout the study.

RECRUITMENT SPECIALISTS

Principal Investigators and Study Coordinators are aided by recruitment specialists, including bilingual personnel, in study enrollment and recruitment. CLINICAL RESEARCH COORDINATORS (CRCs)

Our Research Coordinators are certified through ACRP/SCRS and each team is supervised by a dedicated and experienced manager.
